Railroad Ramble (Salisbury and Lakeville, Connecticut)

Length: 2.14 miles

Surface: Paved (in sections), Dirt and Grass

Difficulty: Easy

Parking: Cannon Park and Walton St (Lakeville)
Salmon Kill Road (limited) and Scoville
Library (Salisbury)

The Railroad Ramble connecting the Villages of Salisbury and Lakeville is one of the few, fully accessible rail trails in Northwest Connecticut. With four parking areas along its 1.7 mile length, it traverses the old Central New England rail bed between Farnum Road in Lakeville and Liberty Street in Salisbury. Traversing wetlands, old fields and railroad cuts, it also has numbered interpretive stations along the way keyed to a guide which can be acquired at several local businesses and from the Salisbury Association, which manages the trail for the Town of Salisbury.
