Demonstration Trail

Roraback WMA

Distance: 1.76 miles of loops

Low Point: 586 ft

High Point: 756 ft

Surface: Mixed surface trails

Difficulty: Easy

Parking: South Road Parking Area

The Roraback Wildlife Management Area in Harwinton is popular with trail riding equestrians as well as hikers, with a mix of woods roads (only some of which are included in this loop trail) and footpaths leading down and around a pond near Leadmine Brook. There is an interpretive trail on a portion of the hike, which passes through fields and woodlands until it reaches the wider woods roads. There are many wildflowers and habitats represented here, as well as habitat enhancement areas managed for the benefit of certain grassland species.
