Beaver Pond Trail

Beaver Pond at Sessions Woods (Burlington)

Length: 2.6 mile Loop

Highest Elevation: 731 ft

Lowest Elevation: 512 ft

Surface: Gravel path/bikes allowed

Difficulty: Easy to Moderate (some steep hills)

Parking: Many options

The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's Sessions Woods Wildlife Management Area in Burlington has a wealth of trails to explore. One particularly rewarding section for families is the Beaver Pond Trail which can be reached from the north or south along the Blue/Yellow Trail managed by Connecticut Forest & Park Association.
